Dear Parents/Guardians

We are revising our masking and COVID-19 guidelines in accordance with the new DOH, OCFS and CDC recommendations:

## Masking

• Masking will be optional for all children.

## COVID 19

- Anyone with symptoms of COVID-19 must stay home for 5 days, with day zero (0) being the date of the onset of symptoms, or until they receive a negative COVID-19 test (whichever is first). Before returning to the program, they must be symptom and fever-free for at least 24 hours.
- Anyone who comes to the child care program with symptoms or who develops symptoms while
  at the program, will be sent home immediately and asked to get tested. Symptomatic children who
  are not infants or toddlers must wear a mask while waiting to go home.
- Anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 must remain at home for a minimum of 5 days with day zero (0) being the date of the positive test result, and must be symptom and fever-free for at least 24 hours before returning to the child care program.
- Anyone who is not an infant or toddler who tested positive for COVID-19 and is returning to the
  program between days 5 and 10, must wear a well-fitting mask up through day 10, or until they have
  had two negative COVID tests taken 48 hours apart, whichever comes first.
- Anyone who is not an infant or toddler who has had close contact with someone with COVID-19
  (meaning having been within six feet of someone with COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes in a 24-hour
  period), must wear a mask at the center for 10 days.
